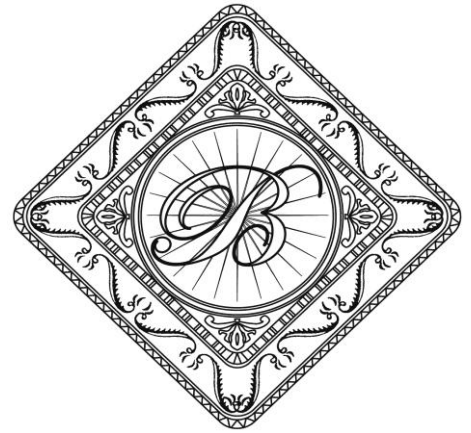


Bugay Vineyards

"From the south-facing slope of the Mayacama Mountains"

Tasting notes:

Massive nose of black currant and liquor-like cassis. Very seductive, with a luscious texture and incredibly complex flavors of black fruits, graphite, liquid minerals and cigar box. Great length, depth and complexity. Tannin are large scaled, but sweet and ripe, carrying the flavors on and on for minutes.

21 months in 'Reserve' French Oak Barrels.

Suggested food pairings:

Prime Rib of beef, fine steaks, roasted herbed lamb, and Osso Buco.
Dark chocolate soufflé.
