Pure and rich aromas of blackberry, plum, blueberry, and spice are deliciously flaunted in this wine. These aromas carry over to the wonderfully complex, and clean taste. The bright fruit is more apparent than in past vintages, and there is just a hint of dark chocolate and earth to compliment the finish. Full and seamless, this wine displays great balance and perfect acidity.
