## 2010 Long Stem Rose

**Appellation:** Sonoma County

**Vineyard:** 100% Bugay Vineyards fruit  
From the south-facing slope of the Mayacama Mountains

**Varietals:** 98% Syrah, 1% Mourvedre, 1% Grenache

### Tasting notes:

This is another wonderful food wine from the Bugay-Watkins winemaking team. Crisp, pure and aromatic. The use of Bandol yeast in the winemaking process imparts a delicious Provencal nuance to this wine. The mélange of berries, fresh-cut strawberry, ruby-red grapefruit and refreshing citrus explode in the mouth. This wine can stand alone, and is best served chilled, but also pairs beautifully with Spring and Summer fare.
